

TARRAS THE CANYON PINOT NOIR is labelled only in exceptional vintages from a single vineyard located high up on the terraces at Bendigo in Central Otago. Established in 2002, grapes from this organically managed vineyard produces distinctive, outstanding Pinot Noir that seriously ages.

SEASON AND VINEYARD

2019 was an excellent vintage up on the Canyon Vineyard. A wet spring replenished soil moisture levels for the warm summer that followed. The vineyard crew kept on top of weed growth by both hand weeding the mechanical tilling. Small berries provided great flavours and we further reduced the crop with "green" harvests to ensure even, consistent concentration and make sure we achieved ripeness at harvest. The vineyard was planted in 2002 and it is broken up into clones 5,667,555 and 115. It is organically managed in harmony with surrounding native plants and insects. The flavours are evaluated and treated separately during harvest reaching optimal ripeness up to 10 days apart between clones.

WINEMAKING

Hand-harvested fruit in perfect condition was destemmed and cold soaked to allow for skin contact and colour development before natural fermentation began in small batches. Gentle hand-plunging to push down the cap. After fermentation wines were gently bladder pressed and racked to barrel denoting free run from the final pressing stages to aid in barrel selection. Maturation was 9 months in around 30% new medium and tight-grain French oak. The Canyon Pinot Noir was made from a selection of these barrels composed to make this classic pinot noir expression. The clean fruit allowed for minimal use of SO2.

TASTING NOTES

Enticing floral notes with intense and pure spicy red fruit aromas. The palate is opulent and complex, wrapped in multiple layers of plush red and dark fruits, fine ripe tannins and characteristic savoury notes that are often attributed to this vineyard alone. Excellent palate length, worthy of cellaring.
