Kin is a deliciously vibrant wine made to enliven any gatherings of family and friends.

A dark and brooding Pinot Noir with aromas of black cherry, plum and chocolate. Black cherry, cola and spice follow through on the palate with orange peel nuances and a distinctive dried herb bouquet.

Vintage

The 2020 season started cool and dry, with warmer Summer temperatures leading into a long, warm Autumn. The season delivered lower yields of small berries, with excellent ripeness and flavour concentration.

Vineyards

A subregional Central Otago blend including fruit from our Estate vineyards in Bannockburn and Northburn.

Varietal

100% Pinot Noir, clones 5, Abel, 667, 777, 115 and 113

Winemaking

Vineyard parcels were individually hand harvested and destemmed to open top fermenters. Gentle hand plunging over a period of 10-22 days ensured the extraction of fine delicate tannins while retaining Central Otagos' signature brightness and juicy fruit flavours.
