

## **2023 CARRICK JOSEPHINE RIESLING**

Arthur's Vineyard, Carrick, Bannockburn, SWNZ BIOGRO-5056

Josephine is the alternative name given by sailors to the Carrick Bend knot. Josephine, our reserve Riesling, is made from selected parcels of grapes hand-harvested from Arthur's Vineyard. The sweetest wine of the range, it is a medium-sweet, mosel-esque style.

Winemaking: Hand-picked, whole bunch pressed, then fermented using native yeast in tank. The fermentation is brought to a close when an appropriate balance of sugar and acid is found.

Harvested: 3rd April 2023

Additions: Bentonite Clay (Fining), Potassium Metabisulphite

(Preservative, anti-oxidant), Yeast Hull Supplement

Filtration and/or Fining: Sterile

Acidity: 9.1g/L

Residual Sugar: 51g/L Alcohol: 10.00%

TSO2 at bottling: 90ppm Bottled: 25-Aug-23

Cases: 450 x6 Bottle cases produced.
