



Pencarrow Pinot Noir 2021

An approachable, bright and lively Pinot Noir with beautiful juicy red fruits and good structure.

COLOUR

Medium ruby

AROMA

Smoky, fruity and savoury; aromas of dark cherry, charred oak, bramble, plum and charcuterie float from the glass.

AGEING POTENTIAL

Enjoy with Peking Duck, Beef Bourguignon or a juicy T-bone steak, medium rare.
Delicious now, this will continue to improve through 2027 and drink through 2030.

PALATE

Plump, silky and intensely flavoursome, the palate is brimming with liquorice and black forest fruits- cherry, blackberry, plum and boysenberry- kissed with smoky, toasty oak and a hint of dark chocolate.

The tannins are supple and fine, teasing out the long, mouth-watering finish.

WINEMAKING

Crafted from Pinot Noir Grapes grown at the Pencarrow, Pinnacles & Woolshed Vineyards. Fermented with some whole cluster and wild yeast, before 10 months ageing in French Oak, of which 25% new.
