WINEMAKING NOTES

Half of the grapes were whole bunch pressed and half were destemmed and soaked to extract colour and texture. The juice was inoculated with selected wine yeasts then half of the juice was barrel fermented in neutral barrels and half was fermented in tank. The fermentation was stopped retaining 5 g/l of residual sugar.

COLOUR

Pale salmon.

NOSE

Charming bouquet of passion fruit, papaya, melon and white peach. Delicate white flowers and grapefruit peel aromas complete this sensorial journey.

PALATE

Dry rosé with a beautiful mouthful texture and tingeling acidity. Fresh melon, white peach and grapefruit flavours will enchant your taste buds.

This gorgeous Kimberly landscape by the late Australian artist John Peart, with colourful hillside shapes which reflects the multi layered vibrancy of the Georgetown Rosé. It is reminiscent of the fruity and efflorescent wine that comes from this small vineyard situated in the Cromwell Basin at Kawarau Gorge in Central Otago. The bottle was specially designed to echo the shapes of the hills and carry the theme of Peart's painting into a unified work of art in its own right.
