Wine Notes

COLOUR	Water white with hints of green.
AROMA	Immense typicity here, guava, melon and gooseberry notes abound.
PALATE	Rich and full, the wine hums Sauvignon Blanc. It is rich, ripe and full with a drying end. Drink now or will cellar well.
FOOD MATCH	Enjoy with summer salads, seafood and white meat.

Vineyard Review

The grapes for this wine were sourced from the Montanne vineyard in Patutahi, Gisborne, where this Sauvignon Blanc was grown using dry farming techniques and this was the first crop off these vines. Traditionally these are one of the first Sauvignon Blanc vines in the region to be harvested each year. The fruit was harvested in good condition with a great flavour, sugar and acid balance.

Winemaking

When deemed ripe by the winemaker these grapes were machine harvested in the early morning with preservative being added in the vineyard, this protects the fruit flavours of the thin skin variety, at the winery the fruit is immediately process and floated into fermentation within 4 hours of its arrival, cool fermented with an aromatic yeast the wine was again stopped when deemed in balance with refrigeration, and racked and sulphured off primary lees. The wine was then stabilised and filtered before being ready for bottling.
