 - Clones 5, 777 and 115
 - Bottled 15th March 2021
 - Alcohol: 13.5%
 - Grapes cold soaked, hand plunged 3 times a day at peak of fermentation
 - 2% whole bunch fermentation
 - 100% French Oak for 10 months

Ripe hand picked fruit, gentle winemaking and maturation in French oak have resulted in a complex and powerful wine. It has aromas of dark plum and chocolate, with a rich silk smooth palate and long spicy finish. A great example of one of the best Central Otago Pinot Noirs. Drinking fantastically well now and will develop and cellar for several years.
