Varietal Composition

Malbec 74% Merlot 19% Cabernet Sauvignon 7%

Vinification

The three varieties are estate grown, hand picked and form the assemblage as harvested and co-fermented with minimal skin contact in stainless tanks.

Skilled winemaking has retaining the incredibly light pink colour, fruit character and freshness befitting a perfectly constructed rosé.
